

Christian Heritage Speech Competition
Impromptu Rules
November 7, 2009

General Topic: Education. See sample questions at <http://www.nmsciencefoundation.org/chsc/impromptu.htm> Also check the links posted.

1. Students will choose three topics from a pool of topics, then pick one of the three on which to speak. Students will have 5 minutes to prepare a 3-5 minute speech; timing begins when the three topics are chosen. Students will be given only one opportunity to speak.
2. Students are not allowed in presentation room until they have given their speech.
3. Use of Bible and other materials or notes during preparation time is allowed.
4. Note cards/notes to remind student of what he wanted to say are allowed during presentation, but not Bible.
5. First place winner will be asked to give a demonstration at the Award Ceremony. If First Place winner is unable or unwilling, Second Place winner will be asked, and so on.
6. Judges may not talk with students about their speeches until all the speeches have been completed. After that, judges will have opportunity to give students feedback.
7. Any questions or disputes should be brought to the Impromptu Coordinator.
